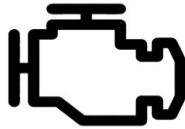

Sadly, I must start my New Year message with the sad news that a very good servant of the Walpoles died recently, namely Richard Broden. He was former chairman of the Parish Council and worked very hard as an active Parish Councillor especially in St Andrews. My thoughts and prayers go to his wife and family.

English Devolution White Paper

The Government published its English Devolution, Power and Partnership: Foundations for Growth paper on 16 December 2024.

The English Devolution White Paper stated the government's plans to widen and deepen devolution across England moving forwards with Mayoral Strategic Authorities in those places where Devolution is not yet in place.

The Devolution White Paper also states the government's intention for two-tier areas in England to be eventually restructured into single-tier unitary authorities.

Aims of The White Paper:

- Deliver sustainable economic growth in every region
 - Reset the relationship with local and regional government
 - Universal coverage in England of Strategic Authorities (Combined Authorities)
 - Empower local leaders and Mayors to make the right decisions for their communities
-
- Rebuild and reform local government – reorganisation of two-tier areas into unitary Council's

The white paper outlines Local Government Reform (LGR) as a way to re-organise Local Authorities, empower local leaders and Mayors to make the right decisions for their communities, and working together to grow an inclusive economy, reform public services and secure better outcomes.

What does this really mean. The full details of the Devolution proposals are yet to be defined. The Norfolk County Council elections scheduled for May this year are likely to be postponed.

As I have more definite information I will update you in the next Crier.

Looking after your Faithful Friend

The Canine Care Card is a free service, which helps to ensure your dog's future, in the event of you either passing away, receiving a life-changing diagnosis or moving into a care home. This can often be a great concern to some people, who perhaps do not have a family member or friend in a position to look after their dog, should the worst happen. Therefore, by signing up to the service, Dogs Trust can offer peace of mind, reassuring you that your faithful friend will be well cared for by the charity.

It is easy to sign up to the service, which simply asks for some information on your dog, including their likes and dislikes, as well as your dog's medical history and your vet details. It also asks for you to confirm who you would like as your Dog Guardian. This should be someone you trust, like a friend, family member, solicitor, neighbour or vet, who can sign over ownership of your dog to Dogs Trust on your behalf, should you become seriously ill or pass away.

You can register online by going to www.dogstrust.org.uk and searching for 'Canine Care Card' - or if you do not have access to the internet, you can request a paper version of the application form. Once the form is submitted, Dogs Trust will then write to you, to confirm when your application has been processed.

Once signed up, should your card ever need to be activated, Dogs Trust will then arrange with your Dog Guardian for your dog to come into the rehoming centre or into foster care. With a team of vets, trainers and behaviourists on hand if needed, your dog will then be welcomed, loved and well cared for by the charity, who will work tirelessly to find a loving new home for your much-loved canine companion.

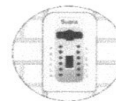

Could you be eligible for fully funded energy efficiency improvements to your home?

The Government's ECO4 scheme aims to help people to pay to make their homes more energy efficient, and cheaper to heat.

For eligible people, this means the Government will fully fund the work needed.

There are two parts to eligibility – the home and the occupants.

The home: must have an EPC rating of D or lower. The Government will only fund works to homes that are not well insulated. You do not have to be a homeowner to be eligible.

The occupants: must have a combined household income of £31,000pa or lower OR at least one person must have a health condition that means they need to stay warm.

If you want to find out more the council will support you throughout the process. We'll assess your eligibility and if you are entitled to the grant we will help with managing the process.

Supporting Norfolk residents to stay

Warm and Well this Winter

As the nights draw in and temperatures drop, health and care organisations in Norfolk and Waveney are supporting this year's Warm and Well campaign to help residents during the winter months.

Norfolk and Waveney's Integrated Care System (ICS) is encouraging residents to ensure their health and wellbeing is 'winter ready' by preparing in advance for seasonal illnesses and offering information and advice about how to stay warm and well this winter.

Bill Borrett, Cabinet Member for Health and Wellbeing and Chair of the Norfolk and Waveney Integrated Care Partnership (ICP), said: "I am really pleased to support the Warm and Well campaign again this year. We all know that demand for public services tends to increase with the onset of cold weather.

"Combined with the ongoing cost of living pressures and the withdrawal of the winter fuel allowance, there is an increased probability that wider health determinants could have a major impact on both Norfolk and Waveney residents' health and our care system. I strongly urge our residents to use the resources available through our Warm and Well campaign as their health and wellbeing is of paramount importance, particularly during the cold winter months."

The Warm and Well campaign highlights some essential ways that residents can stay healthy, warm, and well this winter, including:

- Getting their flu, COVID-19 and RSV vaccinations as soon as they're offered them
- Keeping themselves well by staying warm, keeping active, and keeping a well-stocked medicine cabinet so they are prepared for common winter illnesses

- Advice for people who look after someone at home and how to set up an emergency carer plan
- Signposting people to financial support that is available such as the Household Support Fund, and providing tips on how to make homes more energy efficient
- Raising awareness of pension credit - people over state pension age and on a low income could be eligible for pension credit to help with living costs. Find out more at gov.uk/pension-credit or call 0800 99 1234
- Encouraging use of the range of NHS services available across Norfolk and Waveney, including the NHS 111 service, community pharmacies, Walk-in Centre in Norwich and Minor Injuries Unit in Cromer
- Supporting people to look after their wellbeing and mental health.

This year there is a particular focus on vaccinations and for the first time, the NHS is rolling out RSV vaccine to people aged 75 to 79 and people who are at least 28 weeks pregnant.

Dr Frankie Swords, Executive Medical Director for NHS Norfolk and Waveney Integrated Care Board (ICB), said: "Winter comes to us every year, but that doesn't mean we have to suffer every year too. This year we are offering flu, COVID-19 and RSV vaccines to prevent vulnerable people from getting ill with horrible winter bugs. Please do take up these free jabs if you are offered them – it's the best way to keep yourself well and 'winter strong'."

And remember, even if you got your vaccines last year, you still need to get this year's doses as viruses change and protection fades over time."

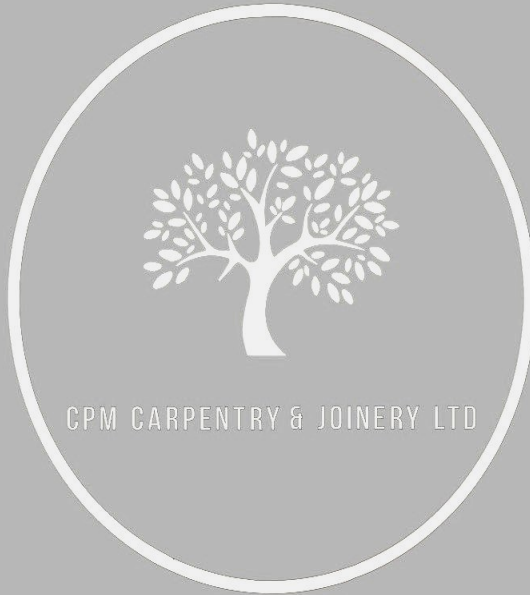

A scam is a dishonest scheme that aims to trick you into giving away your money, personal information, or gain access to your accounts. Scams can take many forms, such as fake emails, phone calls, texts, websites, or social media messages. Scammers may pretend to be someone you trust or a company you regularly use. Reporting a scam can help to prevent further harm to yourself and others. **If you have been scammed, or you suspect a scam, you can contact the following organisations:**

- Action Fraud. You can report a scam online at **action-fraud.police.uk** or by calling 0300 123 2040.
- Your bank or card provider. If you have sent money or given away your card details, you should contact your bank or card provider immediately. They may be able to stop or reverse the transaction and secure your account.
- The Citizens Advice consumer helpline. This is a free and confidential service that can provide you with advice and support. Visit **www.citizensadvice.org.uk** or call for free 0808 223 1133.
- Norfolk Police. You should contact the police if a crime is happening now or has recently occurred. Visit **Norfolk.police.uk** or call 101.

Ongoing talks over Norfolk-Suffolk mayor and unitary

How would a mayoral combined authority impact the role of district councils in Norfolk and Suffolk?

A mayoral combined authority could potentially lead to a loss of local democratic accountability for district councils in Norfolk and Suffolk, as it could undermine the two-tier structure and local distinctiveness.

We are due to have a county council meeting in early January to discuss this, the government is pushing for a decision February / March

I will vote against the proposal for a unitary authority.

I have attended Parish Council Meetings within my Borough Ward and County Division.

Banoffee fridge cake

Ingredients

600ml double cream

250g mascarpone cheese

1 tsp vanilla extract

3tblespoons icing sugar

150g salted caramel plus extra to drizzle

360g digestive biscuits

5 medium bananas, thickly sliced plus extra for top decoration

2 chocolate flakes

(20cm spring-form cake tin, greased with a little oil and lined with cling film)

Method

In a large bowl whip the cream with the mascarpone and icing sugar until soft peaks form.

Pour the caramel into a small pan and melt gently until just runny.

To assemble the cake – layer a third of the biscuits tightly on the bottom of the tin, dollop with a third of the cream mix, top with some banana slices then drizzle over a third of the caramel.

Repeat with the remaining ingredients, finishing with a layer of cream.

Leave to set in the fridge for a least 4 hours or preferably overnight.

To serve transfer the set cake to a plate and top with extra slices bananas, a drizzle of caramel and crumbled chocolate flakes.
